2021 would have seen the 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Kokikai Fall Camp, and though we can't have a traditional Fall Camp, we CAN have the next best thing! Goodman-Sensei, Nachman-Sensei and Burrows-Sensei (three of Maruyama Sensei's senior-most students and instructors in their own right) will do their best to offer a seminar experience second only to Camp with Maruyama Sensei!

Join us in Phoenix, AZ for a weekend of training and fellowship with the broader Kokikai community. We hope you also enjoy Arizona's fall weather, get a taste of Southwest cuisine and culture, and take in the natural beauty of the Sonoran desert, the Superstition mountains, Oak Creek or the Grand Canyon.

## Location: Ability360 Sports and Fitness Center

Ability360 Sports & Fitness Center is a 45,000-square foot, universally-accessible facility located at 5031 E. Washington St. Phoenix, AZ 85034, about 5 minutes from Phoenix Sky Harbor airport. Note that it is a fragrance-free facility, so please bring and use fragrance-free hygiene products during the seminar. There is plenty of free covered parking at the facility. There are dozens of hotels within a five mile radius, and many dozens within a 10 mile radius from lower-end motels to well-known chains.

## Camp Information

Transportation: A 2-minute walk from the Valley Metro light rail stop at 50<sup>th</sup> St/Washington gets you to the gym ([www.valleymetro.org](http://www.valleymetro.org) for fare & schedule), otherwise plan to rent a car, or walk from your hotel. Locals will try to help out, but seminar organizers can't guarantee transport.

Meals: There are a few restaurants within walking distance of Ability360 (many are closed Sunday, unfortunately), and dozens within a 10-minute drive. Phoenix and nearby Scottsdale have some of the finest restaurants in AZ, and Tempe has typical college-town fare.

Social Gathering/Party: We are working on organizing a group get-together (as COVID-safe as possible!) for Saturday night – more details as we have them.

### COVID Protocols

**Most importantly: If you are sick, stay home!** We will refund the registration fee of anyone who needs to cancel because they are sick with verified or suspected COVID, OR because of verified or suspected COVID in their household. Airlines and hotels have been fairly flexible with either refunds or re-scheduling – one of us managed to reschedule their Winter Camp 2020 airfare for flights over a year later!

**We will require proof of vaccination.** You can send a photocopy of your vaccination card with your registration, or show it at seminar check-in. In place of a vaccination record we will accept proof of a negative COVID test dated no more than 72 hours before the start of the seminar.

**We will require that masks be worn** at all times while in the Ability360 facility (cloth or paper masks fully covering mouth and nose, without vents, no neck gaiters or scarves). We **recommend** masks be worn while at restaurants, and while socializing with Kokikai folks.
